These pursuits are based in my belief that we all deserve to live our healthiest and happiest lives with plenty of opportunity for intentional personal growth and creating mutually beneficial relationships. I aspire to create a space for others to come together and celebrate the beauty of life and food through education, exposure, and novel experiences. I have a strong work ethic and work efficiently within and/or leading a group as well as independently. I excel at critically thinking in a farm setting, especially when analyzing farm systems for improvement and planning. The farm environment that I enjoy engaging in is one that pursues financial stability, employee welfare, and regenerative and loving farm practices. I would describe my personality as being dependable, confident, friendly, and communicative.

 - The farm is a 100+ acre for-profit business focused on producing a wide array of agricultural products, including grassfed beef, lamb/goat for meat, chicken and duck eggs, broiler chickens, hogs, vegetables, culinary herbs, orchard fruit and nuts, and Airbnb farm stays and experiences.

- The majority of the animal products are Animal Welfare Approved and pastured while the plant products are based on organic practices but not certified.
- o I am responsible for managing the ½ acre vegetable/herb/flower production for sale at the on-site farm store as well as through retail outlets. I provide daily support for animal tasks such as chores, egg washing/packaging, pasture rotation, orchard harvest/maintenance, etc as well as operation of the farm store and Airbnb cabin.

 - The farm is a permaculture-based agritourism project focused on providing fresh produce, education, and exposure to healthy living practices to the surrounding community and guests through a yurt vacation rental and work-trade CSA.
 - o I was responsible for managing 1/5 acre of field crops and perennials, small fruit/nut tree and shrub maintenance, general landscaping, and a 30'x60' tropical greenhouse growing bananas, papayas, passionflower, and other tropical/subtropical species. I also guided the CSA crew as well as maintain the yurt and surrounding landscaping.

 - The farmstead was a 1/5 acre farm business situated at 3500' that we operated to supply ourselves and our local community with nutritious farm products such as vegetables, herbs, flowers, and pastured poultry.
 - Half of the operation was in year-round operation through permanent raised beds with a 50' hoop house, all for producing intensive vegetables, herbs, flowers, and medicinals through regenerative cropping methods.
 - The other half of the operation was for the production of pasture-raised poultry meat that we were responsible for slaughtering, butchering, and packaging ourselves. We raised 200 chickens, 15 turkeys, and 15 ducks during our tenure.

 - The farm was a 2-3 acre market garden focusing on intensive vegetable, herb, and fruit production and selling through numerous Asheville farmers markets, box-style CSA, and retail outlets.
 - I was hired on as harvest help in 2020 and general farm hand in 2021, helping with tasks such as washing, packing, trellising, planting, bed prep, cultivating, weedeating, and various other farm tasks.
