The Center for Inspired Education, Asheville, NC – Community Garden Intern April 2025 – July 2025

- Grew and/or distributed ~64,500 pounds of free food to people in Asheville.
- Built 780-square-foot worth of fence, beds, borders, and paths and grew 10 kale, 14 squash, 40 beet, 20 radish, 48 carrot, 8 spinach, 15 potato, and 31 sweet potato plants in the Love Project garden.
- Served 3,500 free meals and donated 200 dollars worth of his produce, over 14 consecutive Wednesdays at Haywood Congregational Church.
- Moved 2,000 boxes of free produce, an estimated 10,000 dollars worth of food, for Asheville's latino population, over 10 consecutive Tuesdays at Bounty&Soul's UNETE Market.
- Helped prepare three, 60-foot rows of U-pick flowers, fix a 300 gallon irrigation system, and mix 3000 lbs. of compost, over 8 Wednesdays at Warren Wilson College Garden.
- At Shope Farms he cultivated four, 80-square-foot rows and grew black beans, corn, squash, and potatoes for the Shope Road neighborhood.

- Co-led 3 weeks of Camp Summer Haven for 30 four-to-ten-year-olds and 1 week of Camp Honey Hive through planned Morning cheers, emotional check-ins, songs about the earth, art projects, obstacle courses, cooking lessons, foraging.
